- Exam blocks are 90 minutes. Exams that require more time should be broken specifically into a part I and part II. Do not give students access to the whole exam knowing they will not likely finish. Students should finish and turn it each part on the day it is given. For exam “presentations” that might require more than

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one lab block, be sure to have all students prepare for the first day so no one has an advantage (i.e. select randomly, have an element to be turned in the first day, etc.) If an exam only requires one lab block, it should be given on the second day.

- All DE Calculus seniors 1, 4 will take their exam in the conference room and DE juniors in Lab 1, 4 will meet in the Thinktank. DE Calculus seniors blocks 2, 3 will meet in Think-tank and Juniors will meet in conference room. Modern Physics will take exam 3rd block in Chamber.
- GIS students will stay as needed to complete their exam presentations in one day. There are enough students who won't have a second block exam to make it work.

*MODIFIED EXAM SCHEDULE FOR AP STEM CLASSES the WEEK OF 4/22/19

To provide students the opportunity to receive valuable feedback on their performance prior to AP Exams, all STEM AP classes will give *their SVGS final class exam* the week of April 22.

Classes having exams the week of April 22-26: AP Calculus, AP Environmental Science, AP Chemistry, and AP Computer Science.

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NOTE: AP CLASSES will continue to meet until the day of that AP exam. Students in those classes are to attend as regularly scheduled until the AP exam for that class has been taken.

1. Attendance during exams is critical! If there is an unexpected emergency or significant illness on an exam day, parents are expected to call and provide written documentation for the absence. Exams missed due to illness cannot be made up without a doctor's note. Only absences due to emergencies or exceptional circumstances will be excused during exams. ***SVGS exams take precedent over other school activities.***
2. Students will remain in their exam room during the entire morning. Students may not leave an exam block early. Do not plan appointments during the exam block "after you finish your exam". Students need to be focused on one thing that morning – showing what they have learned through their performance on their exams.
3. If you have 4 classes or mixed programs (AH/STEM), please review the exam schedule and talk with your teacher regarding your schedule.
4. Seniors – If you have two sciences, two maths, two technologies, four classes or hybrid schedule, please communicate and coordinate with your teachers. See me if you have questions. **All senior exams should be taken no later than May 3.**
5. The **Research and Engineering Symposium** scheduled for Monday, May 6 6-8 p.m. will serve as the final exam for junior research, intro to computer science and engineering classes. Students having unavoidable conflicts need to pre-arrange with Ms. Whitesell and will present their projects at different time.
